PURPOSE

Zone 9 was established as a flood control zone of the FC&WCD. Project levees and channels were constructed (within the Stockton Metropolitan Area) with Federal & State funds and must be maintained according to agreements with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and the State of California (Department of Water Resources & Department of Fish & Wildlife). The Public Works Channel Maintenance Division maintains the Zone 9 levee and channel system in accordance with the Federal & State requirements. Non project channels are maintained as funding allows.
